Branch Team 2018

There will be two Branch Team Development Days prior to the start of carnivals. They will be held at Kiama Downs on Sunday 23rd September starting at 11am, and the second day will be at Warilla Barrack Point on Sunday 14th October starting at midday.

- 1. The Branch Team Development days will be for Under 12, 13, 14, 15, 17, 19 years and Open age competitors only. No Under 11, 10, 9, 8 years.
- 2. Any competitor that participates in these Branch Team Development Days must have registered for the 2018-19 season. That is they must be a financial member of their club for the upcoming season.
- 3. Attendance at these Development Days are not compulsory, but highly desirable.

Branch Team Selection Policy

- 1. Selections will now be initially based on the present seasons' results at the Branch Team Development Days and the early season carnivals.
- 2. Attendance at the Branch Team Development Days is not compulsory now, but highly desirable.
- 3. If Development Day participants cannot attend, then they need to advise the Head Team Coach or the Team Manager.
- 4. The team will be announced at least 4 weeks out from the Inter-Branch Carnival.

The 2018 team to be finalised by 12th November.

Other matters

- 1. A list of local carnival dates for 2018/2019 will be put on the SCB website. It includes Country, State, Aussies and other major carnivals.
- 2. 2019 Branch Championships date is set down for Saturday 16th February. The backup date is Sunday 17th February.
- 3. 2019 Branch Champs venue nominations for host clubs to Branch by 12th October.
- 4. It was agreed that it would be good if clubs could host club/development carnivals through the season, so more junior members get more exposure to competition.
- 5. Officials' courses are now done online. It would be very beneficial if clubs could encourage members/ parents to do the online course either early in October, or January, so that they can then get their carnival paperwork signed off at carnivals.
- 6. The Branch Gear Trailer. Any club that borrows the trailer must take note of how it is packed, so that at the end of a carnival, the contents, after being cleaned of sand, can then neatly repack the gear in the correct place.
